2017 Championship Final

EIGHT players, seven rounds, All-play-All
NZCF Rapid rated 40'+10"

2017 Championship finals will consist of EIGHT placings, seven rounds, all-play-all found from the following tournaments in the following manner:

HOW THE EIGHT FINALISTS ARE FOUND:

Three placings - From the previous year's finals - 2016 Championship finals of the year.

One placing - (next-in-line-yet-to-be-qualified) From the first main event of the year.

One placing - (next-in-line-yet-to-be-qualified) From the second main event of the year.

One placing - (next-in-line-yet-to-be-qualified) From the third main event of the year.

One placing - (next-in-line-yet-to-be-qualified) From the fourth main event of the year.

One placing - (next-in-line-yet-to-be-qualified) From the fifth main event of the year.

Additionally all EIGHT qualified finalist players must have played in at least one of the main 2017 events and be NZCF registered for the year - paid promptly after qualification.

Qualified Player withdrawals

If during the Championship cycle a qualified player withdraws from the Championship finals, the vacancy is not automatically filled by the next-in-line player - after the fifth main event if there has been two or more vacancies then the Committee has the option of reducing the total number of finalist places to six.

PAIRINGS: All events will be run using the USCF-Swiss pairings, and using the 'lower colour priority function' in the computer program "Swiss Perfect".

Countbacks - three: If and when necessary; "Total Score" countback (Sum of all one's played opponents scores) will be used to determine the qualified placing/s, and if still necessary, then "Partial Score" (Sum of all the opponents a player has won against plus half the score of the opponents a player has drawn against), and if still necessary then the third tiebreak – pre-tournament seedings.

Pre-tournament SEEDINGS:

First five main calendar events: Club ranking, then if necessary NZCF standard rating, then if necessary NZCF Rapid rating.

Championship finals (NZCF Rapid rated): NZCF standard rating, then if necessary Club seeding, then if necessary NZCF Rapid rating.
